Challenges

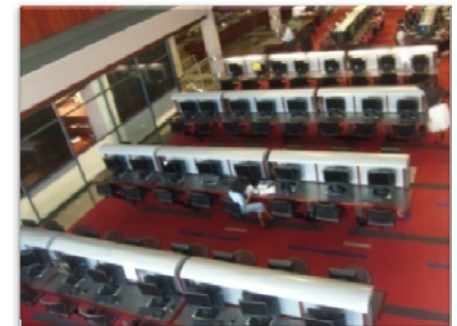
- Shortage of staff

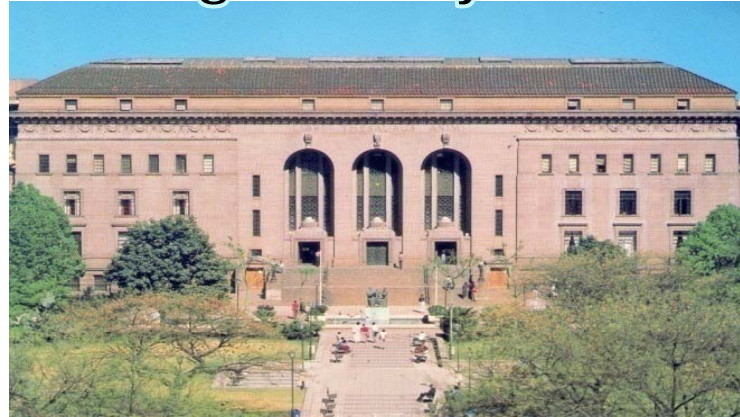
